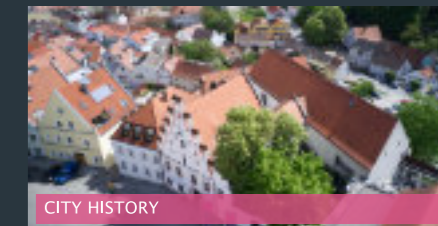

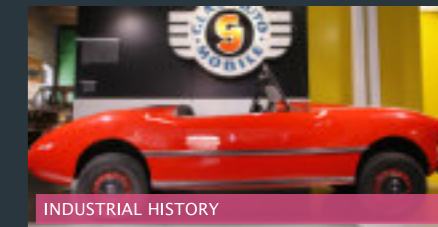

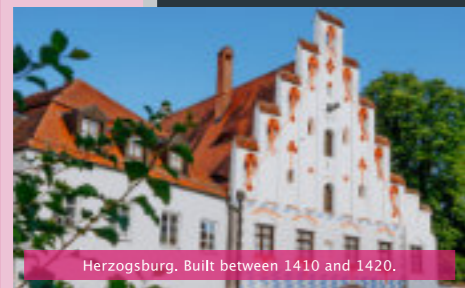
Historical structures in the upper city.

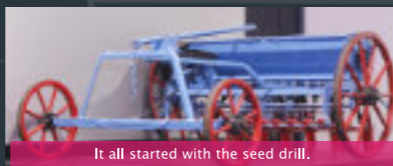

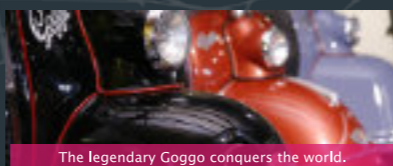

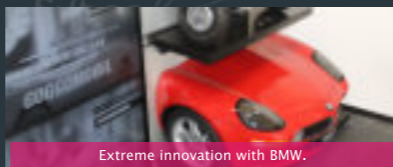
