

Motorhome Parking Rules



Dear guests,

Welcome at Dingolfings' Motorhome Car Park. We provide our park free and plead you to clean up before you leave again.

By using this motorhome parking area, the following rules have been acknowledged:

1. This parking area is reserved for motorhomes only (vehicles category 'M1 SA' or 'SO-Kfz. Wohnmobil'). The parking of cars, caravans, trailers, motorcycles, coaches, etc. is prohibited.
2. Camping (awnings, open fire, barbecues, storage of home utensils, etc.) is not allowed on the site.
3. The practice of any commercial activity such as trading, hawking or performance is not permitted on the site.
4. The motorhome car park is open all year except the month October. There are 12 parking spaces available. The parking spaces are 12 meters long and have a gravel surface.
5. It is not permitted to keep parking spaces free. Reservation is not possible.
6. The parking is free.
Electricity: 1,00 € / 12 h
Water: 1,00 € / 80 l, includes wastewater
7. The motorhome car park is not for permanent living. It is not permitted to stay longer than 3 days / nights.
8. Vehicles, which park without authorization, violate traffic regulations or cause an obstruction can be towed away at the expense and risk of the vehicle owner.
9. The use of the car park is at your own risk. The car park is freely accessible and not guarded. Any kind of claims for damages against the City of Dingolfing are excluded.
10. Keeping order on the car park
 - a) The nighttime peace from 10 pm to 6 am must be observed.
 - b) Dogs and other small animals are allowed, however, pet owners must ensure that other motorhome guests are not disturbed. Animal excrement must be removed immediately.
 - c) Maintaining order and cleanliness is naturally the duty of anyone using the parking area. All systems and facilities must be treated with care.
 - d) The parking space must be left in an orderly condition upon departure.
11. The car park may only be used by vehicles that are approved for public road use and covered by liability insurance.
12. The City of Dingolfing, in exercising its property rights, is entitled to remove people and their vehicles from the site if this appears necessary to maintain safety and order on the car park and is in the interest of the other motorhome guests.
13. Use and access of the course is at your own risk. The road traffic regulations (StVO) apply. The maximum speed on the course is 10 km/h.
